1. ABOUT RHHF

Royal Heritage Health foundation (RHHF) is a Non-Governmental and not for profit Organization committed to creating a society where the poor and vulnerable have equal access to quality education, health, infrastructure and dignity of human person. RHHF is one of United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) Implementing Partners (IPs) in executing projects in Northeast Nigeria.

Royal Heritage Health foundation (RHHF) is a Non-Governmental and not for profit Organization committed to creating a society where the poor and vulnerable have equal access to quality education, health, infrastructure and dignity of human person. RHHF is one of United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) Implementing Partners (IPs) in executing projects in different parts of the country.

RHHF with funding from UNFPA is to Procure and distribute 3,220 customized female dignity kits including culturally appropriate dresses/clothes to the most vulnerable displaced women and girls, Support the distribution of locally produced and packaged dignity kits in Borno State, facilitate Rehabilitation of One Stop Centre, Women Empowerment Center and DK production Centre following flood devastation in MMC and Jere LGAs, Establish 2 temporal clinics to access safe, dignified and confidential SRH services in displacement camps, Conduct A 5-Day training of 40 social workers on GBA case management, MHPSS, GBV concept in Kebbi State Conduct 5-day training and mobilization of 25 Community volunteers on community mobilization and creation on SRH service availability and GBV prevention and response in Kebbi State.

In view of the above activities RHHF is to engage a vendor(s) who will facilitate the rehabilitation of the One Stop Center in Budum, The Production Center and Women and Girls Skill Acquisition Center.

2. OBJECTIVE

The objective of the RFQ is to identify a supplier who can provide RHHF with the above mentioned commodities. The selected vendor is expected to provide such service, based on specific Purchase Orders submitted to the vendor.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO SUPPLIERS:

1. Description of Goods: RHHF request prospective suppliers to submit quotation for the items and services below:

3. CORRUPT, FRAUDULENT, AND COERCIVE PRACTICES

RHHF requires that all RHHF Staff, manufacturers, suppliers or distributors, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of all contracts. RHHF shall reject any proposal put forward by Suppliers, or where applicable, terminate their contract, if it is determined that they have engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices. In pursuance of this policy. RHHF defines for purposes of this paragraph the terms set forth below as follows:

- i. Fraudulent practice is any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, the Procuring/Contracting Entity in the procurement process or the execution of a contract, to obtain a financial gain or other benefit to avoid an obligation;
- ii. Collusive practice is an undisclosed arrangement between two or more bidders designed to artificially alter the results of the tender procedure to obtain a financial gain or other benefit;
- iii. Coercive practice is impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any participant in the tender process to influence improperly its activities in a procurement process, or affect the execution of a contract

4. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

All Suppliers found to have conflicting interests shall be disqualified to participate in the procurement at hand. A Supplier may be considered to have conflicting interest under any of the circumstances set forth below:

- i. A Supplier has a relationship, directly or through third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the Quotation of another or influence the decisions of the Mission/Procuring Entity regarding this quotation process
- ii. A Supplier submits more than one Quotation in this Quotation process;
- iii. A Supplier who participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the Goods and related services that are subject of this quotation process.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE

All information given in writing to or verbally shared with the Supplier in connection with this General Instruction is to be treated as strictly confidential. The Supplier shall not share or invoke such information to any third party without the prior written approval of RHHF. This obligation will continue after the procurement process has been completed whether or not the Supplier is engaged.

6. RHHF'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY QUOTATION AND TO REJECT ANY AND ALL QUOTATIONS

RHHF reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation and to cancel the procurement process and reject all Quotations, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Supplier/s or any obligation to inform the affected Supplier/s of the ground for RHHF's action.

7. OVERVIEW OF EVALUATION PROCESS

Quotations will be evaluated based on the compliance with the specifications stated and the total cost of the goods (price quote).

Following is the evaluation criteria for the quotations to be submitted:

- i. Company registration with Corporate Affairs Commission
- ii. Cost Effectiveness
- iii. Guaranty of Products
- iv. Business Reputation
- v. Price Validity

8. PAYMENT TERMS

100% Payment shall be made upon delivery of Commodities or Services and submission of due documents.

9. DELIVERY

All commodities and consumables ordered shall be delivered in full, No partial delivery except otherwise stated by the Procurement Manager or as specified in the Local Purchase Order.

10. BRIBING

RHHF has zero tolerance policy on gifts and hospitality. Suppliers are therefore requested not to send gifts or offer hospitality to RHHF personnel.

11. PSEA

All vendors that will be engaged shall take all appropriate measures to prevent sexual exploitation or abuse of anyone by it or any of its personnel or any other persons who may be engaged by the partner to perform any services under all RHHF related contracts.

For this reason, vendors shall refrain from any sexual activity with persons less than eighteen years of age regardless of consent or age of majority.

In addition, vendors shall refrain from exchange of money, goods and services for anything of value for sexual favors or any form of degradation.
